The children will read a selection of stories and predict how the different stories will end, and then retell them in their own words. They will focus on characters and ask questions about them, and they link the characters' experiences to their own using drama and role-play. They will decide which story they liked most and give reasons for their choice. The children will have the opportunity to compose sentences orally before going on to write their own compositions about a visit to a farm and the diary of a dragon.

Mathematics

In maths, we are following the Power Maths scheme of work. Children will learn to read and understand numbers to 10. They will use their growing understanding of place value to help them sort, compare and order numbers. We will be focussing on counting in 1s and 2s. We will then be moving on to finding different ways to make 10.

Science

Children will observe changes across the 4 seasons and observe and describe the weather associated with each one. They will explore how the day length varies between the seasons. They will go onto identify and name a variety of common, wild and garden plants along with different trees and describe their basic structure.

History

In History, the children focus on the importance of community and the chronology within living memory of their community. They will develop a sense of how things change over time.

Geography

In Geography, they will name and locate the world's seven continents and five oceans as well as naming, locating and identifying characteristics of the four countries and capital cities of the UK and its surrounding seas.

PE

Children will learn team building activities and games so they learn about sharing, sportsmanship and responsibilities. This links into the work they will do on being a good citizen and part of a community.

RE

Christianity – the children will learn about the Christian creation story. They will retell it and explore how this influences how Christians behave towards nature and the environment.

Art

In art, the children will learn how to draw simple lines of different shapes and sizes and explore how to use these when creating their own pictures.

PSHE

Children will learn about themselves, feeling safe in their environment and how they are part of a community. This will link with their rights and responsibilities as a citizen and a member of Rufford Primary.
